- ✚ **Optical Mouse** : An optical mouse uses laser technology rather than a ball and rollers to compare and track the position of the mouse.
2. **Impact Printer** : Printers that have direct contact between printer head and paper are known as Impact Printers.
- ✚ **Non – Impact Printer** :Printers that do not have any direct contact between Printer Head and Paper are known as Non- Impact Printers.
3. **Recordable CD** : A CD – R is a multi session compact disc on which we can record our own items such as text, graphics and audio; we can not erase the disc contents.
- ✚ **Re-Writable CD** : A CD – RW is an erasable disc that allows us to write multiple times. The disc acts like hard disk, allowing us to write and rewrite data and information on it multiple times.
4. **CVS** : (Computer Vision Syndrome)It is a technology –related health condition that affects eyesight. You may have CVS if you have store, tired, burning, itching or dry eyes; difficulty shifting focus between a display device and documents; difficulty focusing on the screen image; and increased sensitivity to light.

- ✚ **CTS :** (Carpal Tunnel Syndrome)It is a rapidly stress injury (RSI) whose symptoms include numbness, tingling, and pain in the fingers. This condition affects people who type for long periods of time without breaks.
